## Honorariums

Missionary work is generally not the most financially rewarding career that one could have. **We know that we can't give you what you're worth in dollars and cents, but we wish we could.** Even though we are a mission that depends on a lot of volunteer and financial support, we are able to offer honorariums to some who are a part of the team here at Peniel.

Some staff personnel may be eligible for a government grant which will replace the designated honorarium (it is usually a slightly higher amount). Recipients will be decided on by the Director of Ministries.

## Summer Missionary Support (SMS)

The Summer Missionary Support (SMS) Program is designed mostly for those who do not receive an honorarium, but **anyone can be a part of the program.**

How it works is that you get a SMS Form from the camp office to take to your family, friends, church or whoever. Explain to them that you are not going to be working at just any job this summer, but that you are going to be working as a missionary at Camp Peniel. Hand them the SMS Form (which explains the program to them) and ask them to prayerfully consider it. That's all you have to do – we'll take care of the rest.

Whatever support you receive is sent directly to the camp. Our treasurer will then divide up the total support sent in for you according to the number of weeks you are here. You'll get the honorarium when the cheques are handed out every other week. That's all there is to it.

Please note that in order to receive SMS, you must serve for a minimum of 3 weeks during summer camp.

## Other Benefits

No matter whether you receive an honorarium cheque, SMS or both – there are also other benefits included with your position here at Camp Peniel. Some of those benefits include:

- ⇒ **Impact** : you are participating in the Kingdom of God and making a difference in the lives of others
- ⇒ **Room & Board** : we feed you 15 meals, 6 snacks and provide you with a place to lay your head
- ⇒ **Discounts** : all staff get a 10% discount on everything in the Tuck Shop
- ⇒ **Training** : you get high quality training for camp and life for an extremely low cost
- ⇒ **Experience** : working at camp gives you experience in a plethora of areas you can use in other places
