Objective:

- A Cabin Leader will serve mostly in a programming capacity in order to give direct care to campers and carry out the summer camp program.

Prerequisites:

- Exhibit a living, active and growing faith in Jesus Christ
- Be at least 16 years of age during the year of application
- Be physically fit, organized, adaptable, responsible, and show leadership qualities
- Must be able to make mature and wise decisions while working with minimal supervision
- Hold a minimum Emergency First Aid certificate and CPR Level A
- Attend all applicable staff training events

Outline:

- Be acquainted with and abide by Camp Peniel policies and procedures
- Work with the Program Director in executing all aspects of the summer camp program
- Be an active, engaged participant in activities while being a team player
- Oversee and give leadership to LITs and Summer Camp Volunteers
- Properly care for guests, ensuring their health and safety including building strong and healthy relationships, caring for spiritual and emotional needs, managing conflicts, and carrying out proper disciplinary action where necessary
- Prepare for and carry out specific responsibilities and duties including leading cabin devotions in keeping with Camp Peniel's statement of faith, leading skill options, leading campfire songs and chapel times, and sharing your own faith story.
- Be adaptable for changing plans, on-the-spot activities, and rainy days
- Fill out required paperwork in a timely manner
- Be an encouragement and spiritual example to the rest of the staff
- Participate in all required staff activities
- Take consistent time for personal prayer and Scripture reading
